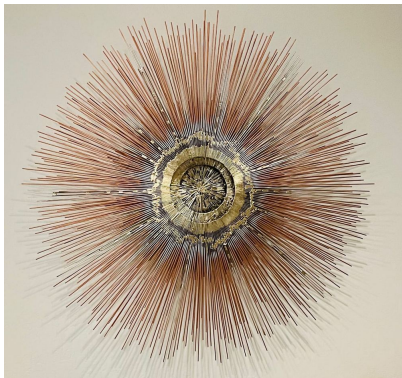
Fredrick Prescott is a sculptor known for his bold, colorful steel works that blend elements of the natural world with imaginative, almost otherworldly forms. His sculptures are defined by dynamic movement, vibrant color, and a distinctive balance between structure and playfulness.

Born in Palo Alto in 1949, Prescott was introduced to working with metal at an early age, spending time in his family's industrial environment learning to cut, bend, and shape materials. By twelve, he had also begun studying watercolor, developing a strong appreciation for color that would later become a defining element of his sculptural work.

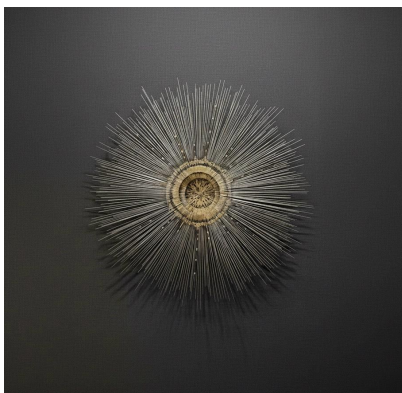
His process combines technical precision with artistic exploration, using steel as both a structural and expressive medium. Through fabrication and painted surfaces, Prescott creates pieces that feel at once grounded in nature and imaginatively transformed, often evoking animals, organic forms, or abstracted environments.

Since 1974, Prescott has exhibited his work internationally and completed commissions for both private and corporate collectors, including major organizations such as Walt Disney Company, Porsche, and the Chicago Bulls. His work continues to stand out for its energy, craftsmanship, and unique visual language.

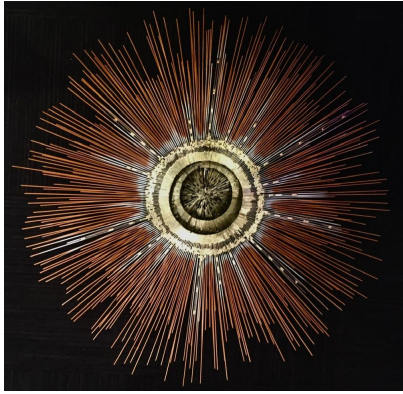
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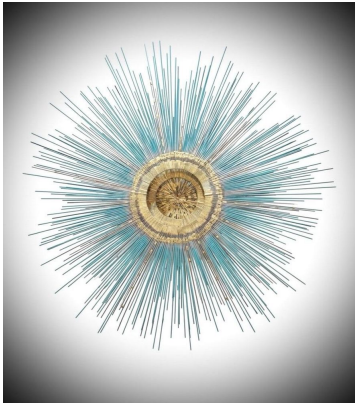

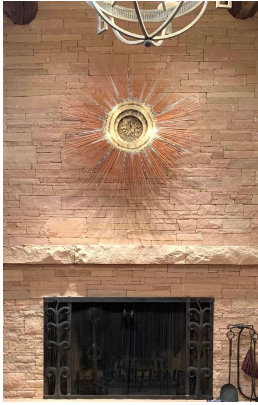
